about us

Since 1982, Guest House of Milwaukee has been successfully accomplishing its mission of providing shelter, housing, education and services to Milwaukee's homeless who seek to transform their lives with dignity and purpose. Onsite, we provide shelter and services to 86 adult men. In recent years, Guest House has added several programs to better serve the evolving needs of our community to include men, women, and families who are at risk of becoming homeless as well as those who have a history of homelessness and require support to maintain their housing. Guest House also offers programs and services for men and women who are interested in gaining and maintaining independence through sustained recovery, stable housing, and employment. Altogether, Guest House serves more than 1,200 individuals between shelter, housing, education, and clinical programs annually. Guest House truly provides **more than shelter** to those in need!

Cindy Krahenbuhl, Executive Director

Cindy Krahenbuhl has led Guest House of Milwaukee as executive director since 2007. Krahenbuhl has decades of experience as a seasoned human resources director with a strong background in management and education. Known to be a thoughtful, competent planner with an ability to create a team environment, she is also skilled in budget oversight and capital campaign fundraising; program and policy development and implementation; and quality oversight.

At Guest House, Krahenbuhl has led the organization from a \$2.6 million budget in 2007 to a \$6.3 million budget in 2017, as well as through a \$3 million capital campaign to renovate and expand the shelter by 8,000 square feet in 2016. She is responsible for overseeing programs and services for the 86 men housed in onsite shelter and for growing the permanent, supportive housing programs from 40 units in 2007 to more than 450 in 2018.

Krahenbuhl was honored as one of Milwaukee's Women on Influence by the Milwaukee Business Journal in 2015.
